

Information for league secretaries

1. USBC has changed the awards for 2011-12. The average required for game awards has decreased by 10 pins and the average required for series awards has decreased by 5. Two new awards have been added: 140 pins over series lapel pin and 75 pins over game lapel pin.
Note: As of 8/11/11, BLS has not updated their software for the new awards. Their website says BLS 2011-12 will be available prior to Labor Day but doesn't show a specific date.
2. Please be timely in turning in your awards. It can be difficult to present an award to a bowler after the league has ended.
3. All USBC honor scores should be submitted on the appropriate USBC form even if it is a duplicate. This is because the award cannot be processed if certain information is not available (such as ball information) and also because it affects the GBUSBC city points that are used in the determination of the all-city team. When using BLS, these forms can be automatically printed.
4. Other USBC honor scores should be submitted on the USBC Special Achievement Award Application. When using BLS, these forms can be automatically printed.
5. USBC award forms can be obtained by going to bowl.com. Then click the Leagues Tab and click on Awards. The form is at the bottom of the page.
6. Local awards must be submitted on the GBUSBC Local Awards application. This application is usually available in the bowling centers and is also available on our website: www.gbusbca.net.
7. Duplicate local honor awards should be submitted on the GBSUBC multiple awards form unless you are submitting previously earned (duplicate) awards either through BLS or other league secretary software.
