

## Open All City Point System and Qualifications

- Any dues paying USBC/GBUSBC bowler in good standing with USBC and GBUSBC.
- Minimum of 54 Games or more in a GBUSBC (USBC certified) League during the current winter season. Season starts August 1 and ends July 31 of the next year.
- Should a tie exist, tie breakers will be used in the following order:  
1<sup>st</sup>-Highest average—2<sup>nd</sup>-No. of houses with 210+ average—3<sup>rd</sup>-No. of leagues with a 210+ average
- Only honor scores and averages bowled in the Greater Birmingham USBC, Inc., (USBC Certified) events qualify for points for the All City Teams.
- A bowler may earn All City points one time only in each Event of the City Open Tournament.

### Points for Average

1 Point	210 to 214 Average
2 Points	215 to 219 Average
3 Points	220 to 224 Average
4 Points	225 to 229 Average
5 Points	230 to 234 Average
6 Points	235 to 239 Average
7 Points	240 to 245 Average

2 Points            Averaging 210 in more than one house.  
Only two highest averages can qualify for average points.
