President Two Year Term

- Duties:
- 1 Presides at all Board and Association Meetings
 - 2 Acts as Spokesperson for the Association
 - 3 Verifies the Association accounts monthly
 - 4 Appoints committees, except Nominating and Youth, with Board Approval
 - 5 Works with all Vice Presidents to insure all USBC obligations and guidelines are and met by the association.

1st Vice President One Year Term

- Duties:
- 1 In presidents absence, assumes all presidential duties
 - 2 Represent the board in assigned centers and Oversee the following committees: Budget & Finance, Bylaws & Policy and Audit
 - 3 Serve the president and Board in any other endeavors for the good of the GBUSBC.

2nd Vice-President One Year Term

- Duties:
- 1 Represent the board in assigned centers and Oversee the following committees: Awards, Nominating, Tournament, Youth and Scholarship.
 - 2 Serve the president and Board in any other endeavors for the good of the GBUSBC.

3rd Vice-President One Year Term

- Duties:
- 1 Represent the board in assigned centers and Oversee the following committees: Lane Inspection, Projects, Meetings and Training, Ways & Means and Yearbook.
 - 2 Serve the president and Board in any other endeavors for the good of the GBUSBC.

Sergeant at Arms Two Year Term

- Duties:
- 1 Assist The President and Vice presidents at all meetings as needed.
 - 2 Serve as advisor on Parliamentary procedure during meetings of the board.
 - 3 Assure prior to meetings that facilities are in proper order.
 - 4 Serve the board in insuring web site is updated with information and announcements.

Director # 1-6 Two Year Term # 7-11 One Year Term (See Below)

- Duties:
- 1 Serve as ambassadors of GBUSBC to leagues and centers.
 - 2 Serve on assigned committees to determine the action of the board in regards to such items as Yearbook, Tournament, Awards etc.
 - 3 Work with League officers and League members to advise and assist as needed.
 - 4 Assist the board in tournament preparation and during tournament operation.
 - 5 Work with leagues and centers to collect and distribute both National and Local awards.

Note on Directors terms.

The initial election will elect 6 Directors (# 1-6) to a Two year Term and 5 Directors (# 7-11) to a One year Term. After the initial election, the following year, Directors positions # 7-11 will be up for re election to a two year Term. This will create a rotation of approximately half of Director positions will be Elected each year.

GBUSBC Representative Volunteer Position

- Duties:
- 1 This position is for individuals who wish to be participate in the GBUSBC without the commitment of being a elected member of the board.
 - 2 Act as a liaison between bowlers and leagues. Volunteers will pass along request and opinions of members to GBUSBC for action and consideration.
 - 3 May be asked to assist in tournament operation, lane inspections and possible GBUSBC committee operations.
