TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1) This tournament will consist of four divisions of youth and adult combinations. Doubles must consist of one adult and one youth.
- 2) The doubles divisions are as follow: DIV 1: 350 & above, DIV 2: 300-349, DIV 3: 250-299, DIV 4: 249 & below, DIV 5, Non-sanctioned adults, DIV 6, Bumpers. Divisions will automatically be assigned.
- 3) Multiple participation in doubles is permitted provided that no two (2) players compete together more than once.
- 4) The Youth Bowler must use book average of 12 games or more from the 2024-25 season or average of 12 games or more as of March 28, 2026. WHICHEVER IS HIGHER. If a bowler has a sport or challenge average only, their average must be converted based on the USBC conversion chart. If a bowler has both sport/challenge or house/standard average the highest average will be used without the conversion. All others will bowl scratch.
- 5) The Adult Bowler must use their Highest fall/winter average from 2024-2025 season of 21 games or more, if bowlers does not have a fall/ winter average, the highest 2024-2025 Summer average of 21 games or more will be used. Bowlers without a fall/winter or summer average, will use their highest current league average as of March 28, 2026 of at least 21 games. All others will bowl scratch.
- 6) All bowlers must be current members of GBUSBC except for participation fee bowlers. All bowlers will bowl 3 games except for bumpers who will bowl 2. games
- 7) Handicap will be 100% of the difference between the entrant's average and 220.
- 8) Awards will be on a basis of at least one (1) out of eight (8) entries in each division. One scratch award per person. All prizes will be returned 100% in the form of an award.
- 9) Youth coaches must send a standing sheet of the required averages to the association manager. Failure to do so will result in the youth bowling scratch.
- 10) Check-in time will be thirty (30) minutes prior to squad time. No blind scores will be allowed. All frames missed will be scored zero (0).
- 11) Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating thereto or therefrom, fire, natural disaster and any other reason beyond the control of the GBUSBC shall cause, to the extent required thereby, any advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of such termination.
- 12) Additional squads may be added during the course of the tournament; however, no squad maybe added after final squad scheduled for 1:30 PM May 3, 2026.
- 13) All USBC rules regarding tournament play shall govern this tournament unless specified otherwise above.
